RAINFOREST ATV TOUR

Zip through St. Kitts' rainforest on a guided ATV tour as you admire the lush vegetation, and catch glimpses of the wildlife that call it home.

HALF ISLAND TOUR

2 to 2 ½ Hours with a Tour Operator Spend part of your day exploring St. Kitts with the help of a trusted local guide. They'll take you to see the island's highlights and make sure you're back in time for lunch.

FULL ISLAND TOUR

4 to 4 ½ hours with a Tour Operator Explore the island's lush natural landscapes, historic monuments, and sweeping views with a local guide on a fully immersive taxi tour.



NATURE HIKE THROUGH THE RAINFOREST

Set a more leisurely pace and explore the rainforest by foot. Your journey into the forest's center is accompanied by an expert guide, and the teeming wilderness.

MT. LIAMUIGA HIKE

Climbing Mt. Liamuiga is no easy feat, but the rewards far outweigh the challenge. Join an expert guide or local tour group and make your way up the dormant volcano, through the verdant rainforest that surrounds it.

BLACK ROCKS

Drive up to the northeastern coast of the island, where rocks originally formed as part of a volcanic eruption have settled into a picturesque outlook over the coast.

SKY SAFARIS ZIPLINING

Ever flown over a thriving rainforest? With Sky Safari, you'll traverse the island from 250 feet above the ground at speeds that can reach up to 80 km an hour.

TIMOTHY HILL

Timothy Hill's peak takes about 25 minutes to get to, if you're walking. Upon arrival, you'll be rewarded with spellbinding 360-degree views of the island that crawl from shore to shore.

NEVIS

Just across the Narrows that lie south of Basseterre, Nevis—our sister island and home to Alexander Hamilton—offers plenty of excitement, from golden beaches to a lush volcanic peak.





WATERSPORTS ACTIVITIES

Parasailing, jet skiing, paddleboarding—what's not to love about a day by the water? Dive, swim, & snorkel to another world with a spread of underwater adventures for all.

CATAMARAN CRUISE 1/2 day

Sail around the island and enjoy it from a unique point of view; half-day catamaran cruises take you on a seafaring journey that includes lunch and snorkeling.

CATAMARAN CRUISE TO NEVIS

Hop on board for a round-trip voyage that starts in St. Kitts and takes you all the way to Nevis, the birthplace of Alexander Hamilton. Aboard your catamaran, you'll get the chance to swim, snorkel, and survey St. Kitts' awe-inspiring beauty.

HISTORIC BASSETERRE WALKING TOUR

The history of St. Kitts' capital city is as rich as it is unique. Explore the storied streets with a knowledgeable guide on a tour that takes you to all of the city's major landmarks—past and present.



CARIBELLE BATIK

The world-famous Caribelle Batik at Romney Manor is an ode to deep-rooted Kittitian tradition, producing fine batik products made of sea island cotton.

FAIRVIEW GREAT HOUSE

Roam the expansive grounds of Fairview Great House, a meticulously preserved old world estate furnished in authentic colonial style and surrounded by a stunning botanical garden.

SCENIC RAILWAY TRAIN

Originally built in the 1900s to transport sugarcane from the fields of St. Kitts to Basseterre, the railway cars now travel across the island on an immersive tour that takes you through the island's countryside, with the help of knowledgeable guides that share the island's history.

OLD ROAD RUM TOUR

On the very site of the Caribbean's oldest surviving distillery, Old Road Rum is reviving the spirits trade in St. Kitts—join them on a tasting and tour to discover Old Road's best-kept secrets.

BRIMSTONE HILL FORTRESS & NATIONAL PARK

Remnants of a long, storied history come to life at Brimstone Hill, an 17th-century fortress recognized by UNESCO as a World Heritage site.
