HOTELS

Marina del Rey has seven hotels with a combined 1,400+ guest rooms and suites. Ranging from boutique to luxury, they offer water views and easy access to the waterfront promenade, Marina "Mother's" Beach, restaurants, and recreational activities.

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ACTIVITIES

Marina del Rey is L.A.'s premier recreational hub for outdoor activities, offering easy access to water sports like sailing, paddleboarding, and kayaking, as well as plenty of thrills on land, including the 22-mile Marvin Braude Coastal Bike Path and Marina "Mother's" Beach, a favorite destination for volleyball, picnics, and playground fun.



EVENTS

Marina del Rey hosts free activities throughout the year, including the Fourth of July Fireworks, Summer Concert Series, and Holiday Boat Parade. Other popular events include the Beach Eats food trucks, Sunset Series Regattas, Marina del Rey Farmers Market, and weekend concerts at Fisherman's Village.



BOATING

As the largest man-made small-craft harbor in North America with over 4,600 boat slips, Marina del Rey offers a variety of watercraft rentals and skippered charters. The Marina del Rey Tourism Board has a list of vetted charter companies at visitmdr.com/charters. City Cruises also offers weekly dining cruises in the harbor year-round.



LOCATION

Situated in the heart of the Los Angeles coastline, Marina del Rey is four miles from LAX and offers waterfront hotels, dining, and year-round water recreation and harbor cruises. It is walking distance to Venice Beach and a bike ride from Santa Monica. Its proximity to major freeways provides easy access to L.A.'s top attractions like Universal Studios Hollywood, Sofi Stadium, and Beverly Hills.

Activities IN L.A.'S MARINA



Located along the Southern California coastline just four miles north of LAX, Marina del Rey is L.A.'s preferred playground for adventures both on and off the water. Home to the country's largest small craft harbor, it's a year-round waterfront destination and sunny hub for leisure, ranging from watersports and boating to dockside dining, shopping, and spa time.



ON THE WATER

DOCK & DINE

Paddleboard, boat, kayak or row to the guest docks at Brizo, The Boardwalk Shops, Fisherman's Village, and Burton Chace Park, or try the patrons-only private dock at Killer Shrimp Restaurant.

SAIL THE COAST

Charter a skippered boat in the harbor for a leisurely day sail up the coast toward Santa Monica and Malibu.

SPORTFISHING & WHALE WATCHING EXCURSIONS

Take the bait and head out on the open water for some sportfishing. Join a public trip (departing daily from Dock 52) or schedule a private charter. Whale watching is also available.

DINE ON THE WATER

City Cruises operates weekly sunset dinner and champagne brunch cruises with live entertainment. Hop aboard at Fisherman's Village.

BOAT RENTALS

Marina del Rey Boat Rentals offers jet skis, power boats, duffy boats, stand-up paddleboards, and kayaks by the hour.

PADDLEBOARD YOGA

Add a new twist to your fitness routine with a YOGAqua yoga session on a stand-up paddleboard in the calm cove at Mother's Beach.

PADDLEBOARDS & KAYAKS

Explore the Marina on a stand-up paddleboard or kayak. Hourly rentals are available at Marina del Rey Boat Rentals, Pro SUP Shop, and Paddle Method.

SURFING AND DIVING EXCURSIONS

Book a private charter for a guided surf, dive, e-foil, or sport fishing tour with Killer Ocean Adventures. Day trips to Channel Islands, Point Dume State Reserve and the Malibu coast are also available.

LEARN TO SAIL

Discover the perfect blend of teamwork and skill-building with sailing lessons designed to elevate group bonding. Private and group lessons available with various charter companies.

PARASAILING

Soar high above the Pacific and take in the bird's-eye view of Venice Beach and the Santa Monica Pier with Marina del Rey Parasailing.



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BY THE WATER

BALLONA WETLANDS

Discover the 600-acre Ballona Wetlands, a protected habitat and home to hundreds of plant species and birds, on a docent-led tour or follow the perimeter's walking trail to explore at your own pace.

MOVIES

Enjoy dinner and a movie at the nearby Villa Marina Marketplace featuring premier restaurants like Ruth's Chris Steakhouse and two AMC movie-theaters, or catch a free, family-friendly film outdoors at Burton Chace Park on select summer and winter nights.

SUNSET SAILS

Stake a spot at Burton Chace Park, Fisherman's Village or the jetties – or hop aboard one of City Cruises' sunset cocktail voyages – to catch the California Yacht Club's Sunset Sailing Regatta, held April through Sept.

NIGHTLIFE

Dance under the stars on a dining cruise, groove to a live music or DJ set on a waterfront restaurant patio, and learn salsa to the rhythm of a live band. When the sun goes down, the fun continues in L.A.'s Marina!

POTTERY CLASSES

Get creative by the coast with hands-on pottery classes in a welcoming studio environment. Perfect for those looking to unwind, learn a new skill, or spark some creative energy.

LIVE MUSIC

From free, year-round concerts at Fisherman's Village to live music at hotels, restaurants and aboard dining cruises to the Summer Concert Series at Burton Chace Park, live music is everywhere in the Marina.

SHOPPING

Discover chic and trendy boutiques and personal care services at the Marina's open-air retail and dining destinations, including Waterside, Fisherman's Village, and the Boardwalk Shops, or head to nearby Abbott Kinney for a more eclectic shopping scene.

WATERFRONT DINING

Mild temperatures make dining outdoors a year-round pleasure. From sunset cocktails to champagne brunch, the Marina's waterfront patios offer coastal breezes and beautiful harbor views.

SOOTHING SPA DAY

Indulge in massage treatments, body scrubs, facials, and more at The Ritz-Carlton, Marina del Rey's Sisley Spa.

BIKE THE BEACH

Take in the ocean views from the 22-mile Marvin Braude Coastal Bike Trail. Bike rentals are available at Fisherman's Village, Venice Pier and at some Marina del Rey hotels.

FOOD TRUCKS

Gather at sunset at Mother's Beach for live music and flavorful food truck fare at "Beach Eats" every Thursday from May through Sept.

FARMERS MARKET FUN

Check out all the seasonal goodness at the Marina del Rey Farmers Market every Saturday, 9 am – 2 pm at the corner of Panay Way and Via Marina.



GETTING HERE

Only 4 miles north of LAX, Marina del Rey is a 10-minute drive from the airport. Additionally, the Marina's close proximity to major Los Angeles freeways makes it easily accessible for visitors to get around the city.

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ITINERARY

if you have 2 HOURS



Marina del Rey is equally relaxing and engaging. Any of the following activities will get you into the fresh air for a short while and treat you to scenic views.



Taste the Marina's **culinary offerings** in any of our popular restaurants that boast harbor views, outdoor terraces, and acclaimed chefs. **Time: 1-2 hours.**



Experience the stand-up **paddleboarding** craze with hourly rentals available through Marina del Rey Boat Rentals, Pro SUP Shop, or the UCLA Marina Aquatic Center. **Time: 1-2 hours.**



Daniel's Bicycle Rentals in Fisherman's Village rents by the hour, so you can enjoy a quick ride on a segment of the Marvin Braude Coastal Bike Trail, or just pedal around the Marina. **Time: 1-2 hours.**



Jetski, kayak, or captain your own electric boat with hourly rentals from Marina del Rey Boat Rentals in Fisherman's Village. **Time: 1-2 hours.**



Enjoy a **waterfront picnic in Burton Chace Park**. This green space has a perimeter walking path with views of passing sailboats and other watercraft, as well as picnic tables and barbecues. **Time: Up to you.**



Explore the neighboring **Ballona Wetlands**, home to more than 200 species of wildlife. One- or two-hour docent-led tours are available on select weekend days (inquire for details), or go at your own pace on a public walking path that traces the perimeter. **Time: 1-2 hours.**



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ITINERARY

if you have 4 HOURS



In a half-day, you can start to dig in to Marina life. Enjoy the sunshine and sparkling harbor views on one or more of these excursions.



City Cruises offers the only public **dining cruises** in the Marina. Depending on the day and time of your visit, consider a brunch or dinner sailing with musical entertainment. From spring through early fall, City Cruises adds to the lineup with sunset cocktail cruises on Wednesdays, timed so you can watch the California Yacht Club's Sunset Series Regatta. If you rent a boat, kayak or paddleboard, you can also dock and dine at spots like Brizo, Killer Shrimp and Fisherman's Village. **Time: About 3 hours.**



Get a bird's-eye view of the entire Los Angeles coastline on an excursion with **Marina del Rey Parasailing** (March-October). Choose from 500 or 800 feet. **Time: About 2 hours.**



Pedal along the 22-mile **Marvin Braude Coastal Bike Trail**, which winds through Santa Monica, Venice Beach, and other seaside towns to the north and south of the Marina. Hourly or full-day rentals are available from Daniel's Bike Rentals at Fisherman's Village. **Time: Up to you.**



Shop 'til you drop at Waterside, the Marina's outdoor shopping center, or take a quick jaunt to Abbot Kinney Boulevard in Venice, which is lined with funky boutiques and restaurants. **Time: Up to you.**



Bike or walk to nearby Venice Beach and enjoy the carnivalesque Boardwalk scene with street performers, beachfront cafes, and colorful characters. Head a little more north to Santa Monica for popular shopping on Third Street Promenade. **Time: Up to you.**

if you have A FULL DAY



You're the ultimate leisure traveler! You could easily pair a couple of activities from the quick-stay sections, or indulge in one of the following signature sightseeing opportunities.



Charter a skippered yacht and sail along the Los Angeles coastline. Enjoy views of popular landmarks like the world-famous Venice Beach Boardwalk or the Santa Monica Pier's amusement park.



Join a public **deep-sea fishing excursion** into Santa Monica Bay with Marina del Rey Sportfishing. Choose from open-party (public) half-day and three-quarter-day fishing trips. If you're visiting in winter, this same vendor offers whale-watching trips. **Time: 5-9 hours.**



Indulge in a relaxing day at The Ritz-Carlton, Marina del Rey starting with a well-deserved spa treatment at Sisley Spa, the only one of its kind on the West Coast. Then, catch some rays at the hotel's waterfront saltwater pool, followed by a satiating meal on the patio at Cast & Plow overlooking the harbor and sparkling water. **Time: 6+ hours**



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
